

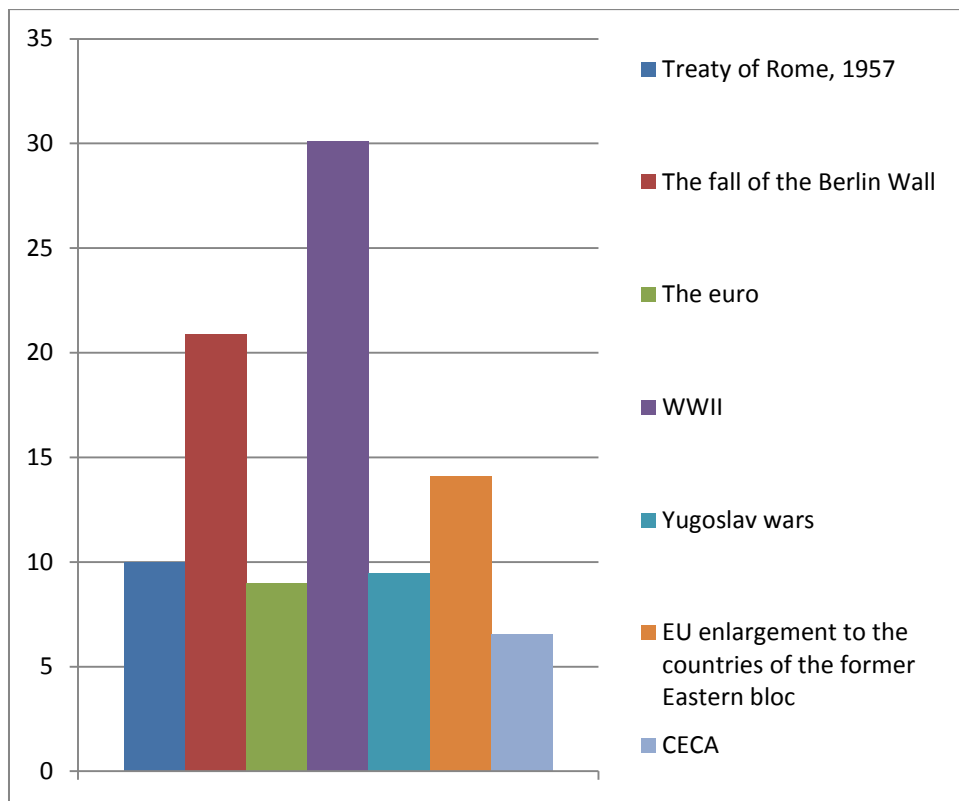
Opinion report synthesis

Chose an important event about the European History and/or European construction

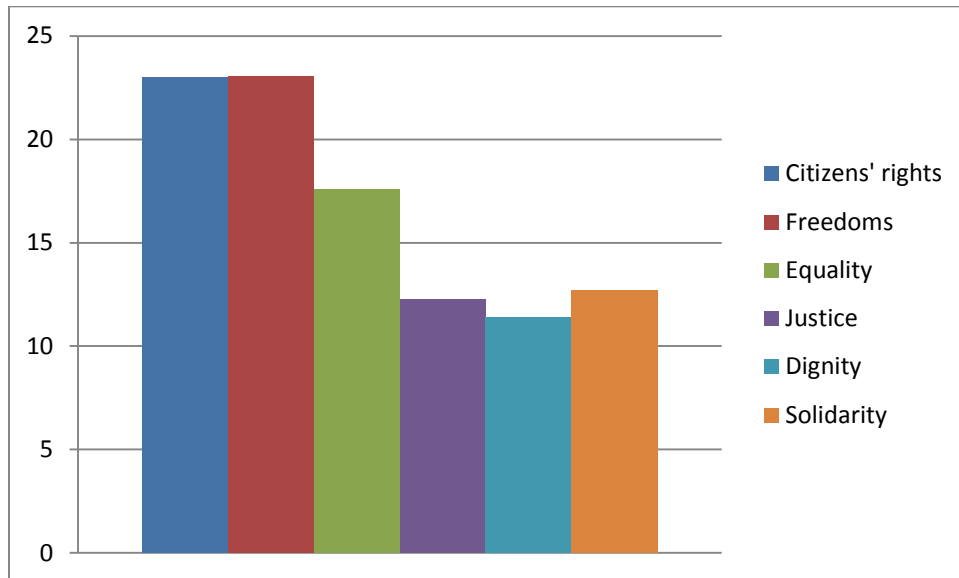


In all the ten countries participating in this survey, almost all citizens interviewed mentioned World War II has the turning point of European history.

The treaties of Rome were mostly mentioned by countries already part of the E.U, whereas candidate countries choose to mention the Yugoslav wars or the fall of the Berlin Wall.

Choose the value defended by the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the EU, which is the most important to you

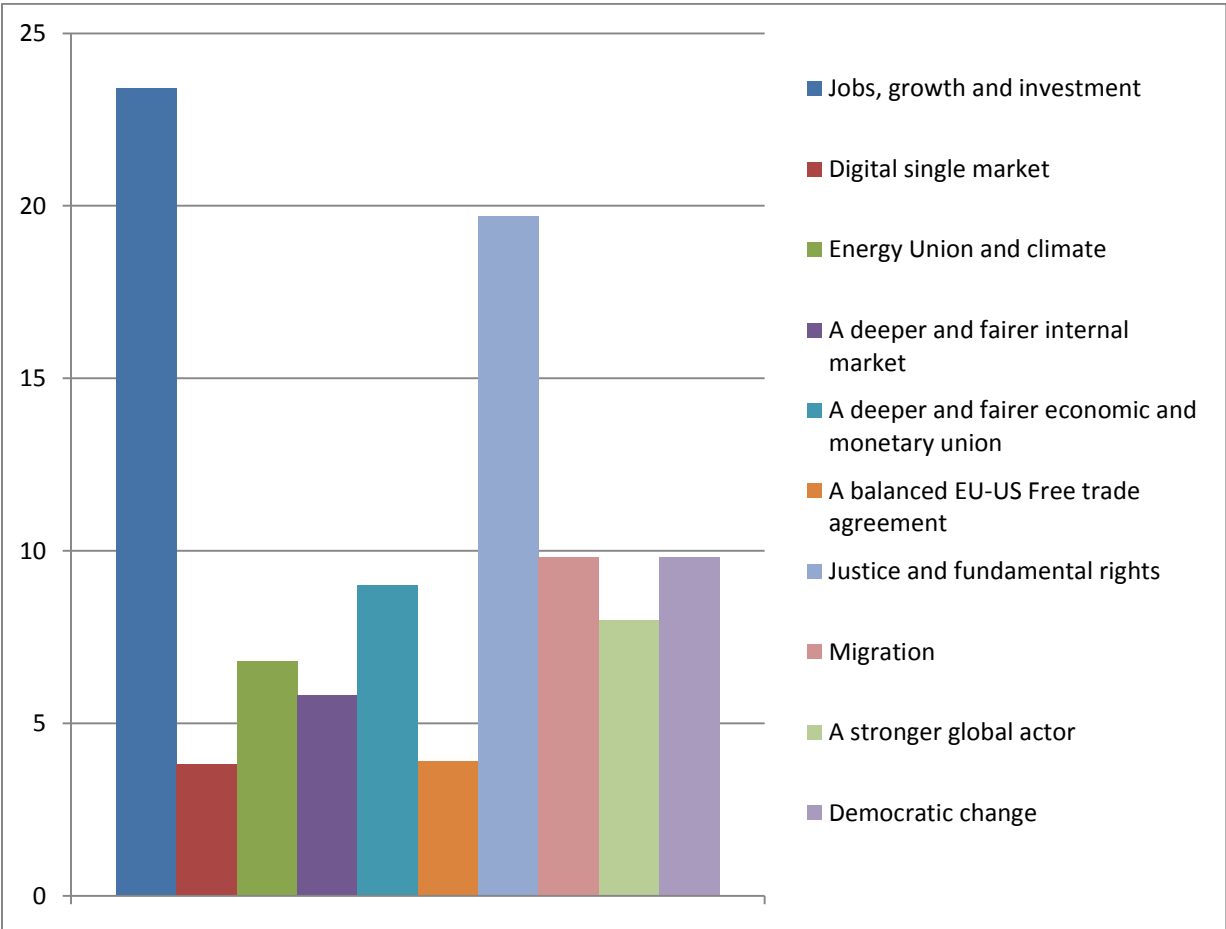


The value “solidarity” was chosen by 32% of the Spanish respondent, yet, it was the lowest picked value by the other respondents of all countries.

As for “Citizen’s right”, it was picked by more than 40% of the respondent of Serbia and Romania. The values of “Citizen’s right” and “Freedom” were always higher up in the Balkans countries.
